Request by Save Our Hills

As noted in our Minute #2, Save Our Hills (SOH) sent an email to the hearing
administrators dated 6 July 2020 requesting that the hearing date be postponed. SOH cited
a variety of reasons for that request, principally related to scheduling issues around expert
witness conferencing in relation to flood modelling. SOH reiterated its request in an email
dated 20 July. This Minute responds to that request and the related conferencing issue.

Expert Conferencing

- Conferencing between the flood modelling experts Mr Law (acting for GWRC/UHCC) and Mr Kinley (acting for the applicant) took place on 21 July, and their report was provided to all parties on 23 July. Experts acting for SOH were unable to attend that meeting, whether in person or via video link.
- 3. Further conferencing may take place between the SOH / GWRC / UHCC flood experts on Tuesday 28 or Wednesday 29 July, but that has not yet been confirmed.
- Regardless of whether that potential conferencing takes place, the parties may find value in further conferencing during the days of the hearing. We therefore encourage them to be prepared for that possibility.

Provision of Evidence

- 5. Based on the timetable set in earlier advice to all parties, evidence from the SOH expert or experts was required to be circulated to all parties today (Monday 27 July). We require this timeframe to be met.
- 6. If the possible conferencing takes place this week (Tuesday 28 or Wednesday 29 July), SOH can provide supplementary evidence if their position has changed due to the conferencing outcomes. If supplementary evidence is provided, we require it by no later than 3pm the day after conferencing has occurred. We also require a report of the conferencing outcomes in the same timeframe.

Decision on Requested Postponement

7. As noted above, by the end of this week additional conferencing may have occurred. The parties will also be in receipt of written evidence from SOH which must be provided today. In addition, a substantial amount of time has been allocated to SOH in the hearing schedule to present its case – as indicated by the hearing scheduled attached to this Minute. In these circumstances we consider that there is no need to postpone the hearing.

8. We therefore reconfirm that the hearing to consider the resource consent application and notice of requirement will commence on 3 August 2020, at 9am at the Cosmopolitan Club, 11 Logan Street, Upper Hutt.
