## **NOTICE OF AMENDMENTS TO THE UPPER HUTT CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT PLAN 2004**

### REMOVAL OF MINIMUM CAR PARKING REQUIREMENTS

Following Central Government's direction in Policy 11 and clause 3.38 of the National Policy Statement on Urban Development 2020 (NPS-UD), Upper Hutt City Council has amended the District Plan, removing all objectives, policies, rules, and assessment criteria (formerly) requiring a minimum number of car parks to be included in developments within Upper Hutt.

This notice is given in accordance with Section 55(2A)(b) of the Resource Management Act 1991. As required under this section, these amendments to the District Plan have been made without using the typical (Schedule 1) public submission process for plan changes. These changes take effect from 18 February 2022.
