## Public Notification of the Summary of Decisions Requested for Proposed Plan Change 47 to the Upper Hutt City Council District Plan (2004) – Natural Hazards

Upper Hutt City Council gives notice as required by clause 7 of the First Schedule of the Resource Management Act 1991, of the availability of a Summary of Decisions Requested (Summary of Submissions) by persons who made submissions on Proposed Plan Change 47 to the Upper Hutt City Council District Plan 2004.

The purpose of Proposed Plan Change 47 is to update the natural hazards provisions in the Natural Hazards Chapter of the Upper Hutt City District Plan. The proposed plan change:

- updates natural hazard objectives, policies, rules, and mapping that relate to the Wellington Fault.
- introduces natural hazard objectives, policies, rules, and maps pertaining to the proposed High Slope Hazard Overlay and Poor Ground Conditions Overlay in Mangaroa. The current District Plan provisions do not address these two hazards.
- updates the earthworks and subdivision provisions in relation to natural hazards.
- introduces a definition for Hazard Sensitive Activities, Potentially Hazard Sensitive Activities, and Less Hazard Sensitive Activities.

**Please note:** In addition to serving a copy of the further submission to Upper Hutt City Council, a copy of the further submission must also be served on the person(s) who made the original submission to which the further submission relates. This must be done no later than five working days after providing Upper Hutt City Council with the further submission.

## **Process for public participation**

The proposal for public participation in the consideration of the proposal under the Act is as follows.

After the close of further submissions, Council will conduct a hearing if needed. Everyone who made a submission or further submission, and who requested to be heard, will be advised of the dates and times of the hearing, and will be given an opportunity to attend and speak to Council in support of their submission. Any person who has made a submission or further submission has the right to appeal Council's decision on the proposal to the Environment Court.
