

# PUBLIC NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED PLAN CHANGE 47 — NATURAL HAZARDS CHAPTER TO THE UPPER HUTT CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT PLAN (2004)

The purpose of Proposed Plan Change 47 is to update the natural hazards provisions in the Natural Hazards Chapter of the Upper Hutt City District Plan. The proposed plan change:

- Introduces a definition for Hazard Sensitive Activities, Potentially Hazard Sensitive Activities, and Less Hazard Sensitive Activities.
- Updates natural hazard objectives, policies, rules, and mapping that relate to the Wellington Fault.
- Introduces natural hazard objectives, policies, rules, and maps pertaining to the proposed High Slope Hazard Overlay and Poor Ground Conditions Overlay in Mangaroa. The current District Plan provisions do not address these two hazards.
- Updates the earthworks and subdivision provisions in relation to natural hazards.

The proposed plan change would mean that:

- Less Hazard Sensitive Activities are permitted in the Wellington Fault, High Slope Hazard, and Poor Ground Conditions Overlays.
- Hazard Sensitive and Potentially Hazard Sensitive Activities in the Wellington Fault Overlay would require resource consent.
- Subdivision within the Wellington Fault Overlay would need to consider the risk associated with the subdivision and fault rupture.
- All earthworks for building platforms for identified Hazard Sensitive Activities would need resource consent in the High Slope Hazard Overlay; and
- All subdivisions in the Poor Ground Conditions Overlay would require resource consent.
