Proposed (Private) Plan Change 40 – Wallaceville

Proposed (Private) Plan Change 40 seeks to rezone approximately 63 hectares of the former Wallaceville Ag-Research site and a small part of the Trentham Racecourse property for residential and commercial uses. This includes:

- Rezoning the majority of the properties from Special Activities Zone to Residential, Residential (Centres Overlay) and Business Commercial Zones;
- Rezoning a portion of the area located south of Alexander Road from Rural Hill to Residential and Residential (Centres Overlay); and
- Retaining the existing Rural Hill zoning over the remaining portion of the area located south of Alexander Road.

The submission must be completed on Submission Form (Form 5) and must state whether or not you wish to be heard on your submission. Copies of the Submission Form are available on the website and from Council.

Process for public participation

The process for public participation in the consideration of the proposal is as follows:

- after the closing date for submissions, the Council will prepare a summary of decisions requested by submitters and give public notice of this summary, including where the summary and submissions can be viewed
- there will be an opportunity for the following persons to make a further submission in support of, or in opposition to, the submissions already made:
 - any person representing a relevant aspect of the public interest
 - any person who has an interest in the proposal greater than the general public has
 - the Council itself
- if a person making a submission asks to be heard in support of his or her submission, a hearing will be held
- the Council must give its decision on the provisions and matters raised in the submissions (including its reasons for accepting or rejecting submissions) and give public notice of its decision within 2 years of notifying the proposal and serve it on every person who made a submission at the same time
- any person who has made a submission has the right to appeal against the decision on the proposal to the Environment Court if:
 - in relation to a provision or matter that is the subject of the appeal, the person referred to the provision or matter in the person's submission on the proposal; and
 - in the case of a proposal that is a proposed policy statement or plan, the appeal does not seek the withdrawal of the proposal as a whole.
