We purchased our property in Whitemans Valley 4½ years ago for the rural lifestyle within Whitemans Valley which is unique, with a unique small community.

I am concerned that the changes suggested in the Draft PC50 plan will result in the loss of our unique rural character in Upper Hutt, removing the openness of the countryside, fragment larger blocks of land and create some areas with with a higher density of homes/buildings.

Lack of Consultation

There has been a lack of transparently in the process and documents, consultation with the public on PC50, especially with those people residing in the rural areas affected; eg properties near the proposed Berketts Farm development of 100 houses. Upper Hutt City Council has failed to consult adequately on the development with little consideration of the public that are not familiar with the process and how to provide a valid submission.
