

Public Notification of Summary of Submissions on Proposed Plan Change 44 to the Upper Hutt City Council District Plan (2004) – Temporary Events

The Upper Hutt City Council gives **NOTICE** as required by clause 7 of the First Schedule of the Resource Management Act 1991, of the availability of a summary of decisions requested by persons making submissions on Plan Change 44 to the Upper Hutt City Council District Plan 2004.

Proposed Plan Change 44 (“Plan Change 44”) – *Temporary Events* – seeks to update related objectives and provisions within the District Plan to current best practice standards. These proposed changes are in response to how event organisers currently manage events, and issues which have been identified in the evaluation of current provisions, and historic consenting.

The submission must be completed on Submission Form (Form 6) and must state whether or not you wish to be heard on your submission. Copies of the Submission Form are available on the website and from Council. Further submissions must be received by **5pm, 21 March 2018**.

Any person representing a relevant aspect of the public interest and any person with an interest in the Plan Change greater than the interest of the general public has may make a further submission in support of or opposition to any one or more of the previously received submissions.

Please note: In addition to serving a copy of the further submission on the Upper Hutt City Council, a copy of the further submission must also be served on the person(s) who made the original submission to which the further submission relates. This must be done no later than 5 working days after providing the Upper Hutt City Council with the further submission.

Process for public participation

After the close of further submissions, Council will conduct a hearing if needed. Everyone who made a submission or further submission and who requested to be heard will be advised of the dates and times of the hearing and will be given an opportunity to attend and speak to the Council in support of their submission. Any person who has made a submission or further submission has the right to appeal Council's decision on the proposal to the Environment Court.
