Upper Hutt Community Patrol (UHCP) is staffed by unpaid volunteers, who give up their time and take responsibility for 'reducing crime and building a safer community' within Upper Hutt.

Community Patrols do this by providing additional 'eyes and ears' for Police and working with a wide range of other groups within the Community, to make Upper Hutt (and the wider Hutt Valley) a safer place for everyone.

UHCP's patrols currently operate within Upper Hutt on Friday and Saturday nights and during daylight hours on Mondays and Thursdays. UHCP also has a presence at public events.
