Harvesting - at least 20 and no more than 60 working days before the planned commencement date, or, in the case of harvesting for salvage operations, at least 2 days before such harvesting is planned to begin. Forest quarrying - at least 20 and no more than 60 working days before the planned commencement date, or, in a green or yellow erosion susceptibility zone at least 10 and no more than 20 working days before, or annually for ongoing activity. Replanting - at least 20 working days and no more than 8 months before the planned commencement date. Is any clearance of indigenous vegetation proposed? (refer Regulation 93)							
Please note: For the activity to be permitted it must comply with all applicable permitted activity conditions in the NES-CF, including those relating to ancillary indigenous and non-indigenous vegetation clearance, and the general provisions relating to noise, vibration, dust, and indigenous bird nesting. The Council may charge for the monitoring of permitted activities in accordance with Regulation 106 Declaration of Permitted Activity Notifier I/We the undersigned acknowledge that the permitted activity is to be held in my/our name as described above and accept liability for all charges associated with the monitoring of this permitted activity.
